



India Stonemart 2019 (ISM 2019) - International Stone Industry Exhibition was successfully organized by CDOS in association with FICCI with the support of RIICO and Government of Rajasthan during January 31 - February 3, 2019 at Jaipur Exhibition and Convention Centre, Sitapura, Jaipur.

The event, organised in a total area of 45,000 sq.m with more than 19,000 sq.m net exhibit space, is the largest stone industry exhibition in India. The event witnessed turnout of about 35,000 visitors out of which 27,000 were trade visitors. These include around 1800 trade visitors from 52 countries. 484 exhibitors from different parts of India and 7 countries displayed their products in the exhibition.

1256 business meetings of exhibitors and registered overseas buyers were organised during the Buyer-Seller Meet. 30 stone artisans displayed their products in the Shilpgram which was one of the star attractions during ISM 2019.



INAUGURATION



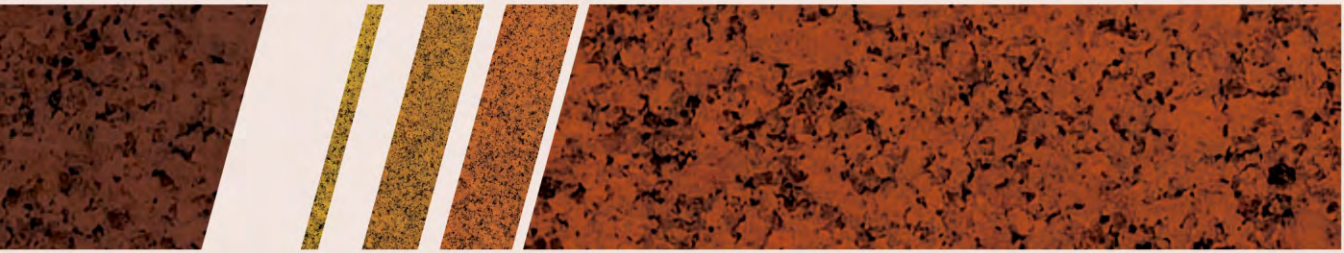
ISM 2019 was inaugurated by Shri Ashok Gehlot, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Rajasthan.

The event was inaugurated on 31st January, 2019 by Hon'ble Chief Minister, Rajasthan in the august presence of Hon'ble Industries Minister, Rajasthan, other dignitaries and luminaries of the stone industry.

In his inaugural address, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Rajasthan Shri Ashok Gehlot said that the time has come for fostering an environment where no permissions are required for setting-up new industries in the State.

The Chief Minister said that such a revolutionary idea is required to create adequate number of jobs and eradicate unemployment. He also said that creating jobs is a challenge for any government and therefore, it would be important to remove all obstacles, in setting up new industries. "Rajasthan has rich reserves of minerals and stones and we

would like to help the industry in exploiting this potential", the Chief Minister said and invited all stakeholders to work with his Government to develop a policy that will ensure ease of doing business while at the same time protecting the environment. He reiterated the words of Shri Parsadi Lal Meena, Hon'ble Minister for Industries, Rajasthan that his Government is committed to ensuring ease of setting up and expanding businesses across industries especially in the stone sector. It is a jewel in the economic plans of the State and provides employment to a large number of people. "We are trying to make a policy in which no permission will be required to setup new industries and our primary focus would be the MSME sector which employs a lot of people". He emphasized the need for a collective effort of the industry and Government to ensure that while the industry grows and flourishes, the environment is also protected at all costs. He also called upon the



industry people to adopt newer technologies for optimum utilization of resources and reducing wastage.

Hon'ble Industries Minister Shri Parsadi Lal Meena said that adoption of new technology can reduce adverse impact on the health of the workforce. He requested the Chief Minister to bring out a new industrial policy which will provide special facilities and incentives for setting up new industries.

Chief Secretary Shri D.B. Gupta said that international events like 'India Stonemart' will definitely act as a catalyst for attracting investment and industrial development in the state. Stonemart firmly established itself at the international level and unveiled how India has emerged as a major player in the sector, he added. "We need to add environment friendly modern techniques and machinery to become more competitive", he said.

Chairman RIICO & CDOS Shri Kuldeep Ranka said that the state has got huge untapped potential in the stone sector. "CDOS was established to bring together different sectors of the industry under one roof and I am happy to note that the Centre has lived upto its role", he added.

Earlier in his welcome address, CDOS Vice Chairman Shri Ashok Kumar Dhoot said that the industry has been going through a slowdown and requested Hon'ble Chief Minister to take up the issue of reduction of Goods and Services Tax rate for the Stone industry with the Centre. He also hoped that an Export Promotion Council would soon be set up on the lines of other sectors.

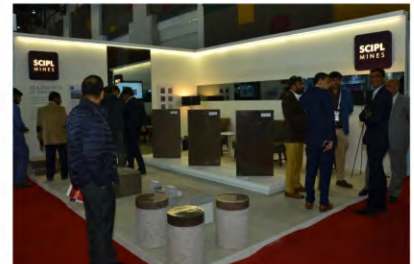
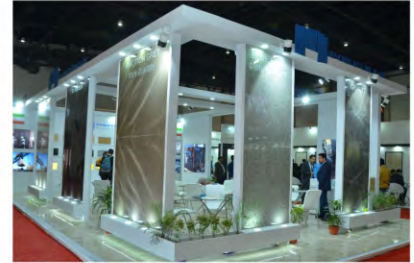
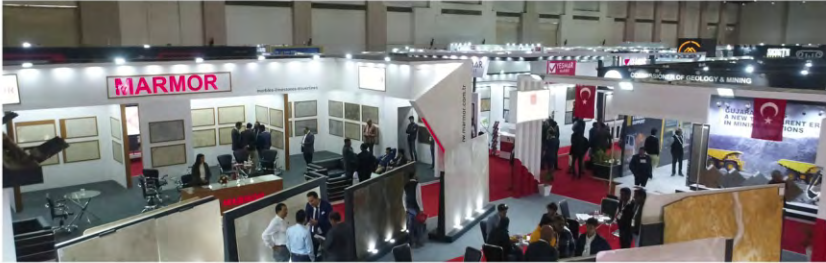

An 'Architects Gallery' was set up during the festival to display award winning projects of All India Stone Architectural Awards and some reputed projects from Rajasthan, highlighting different usage and applications of dimensional stones.

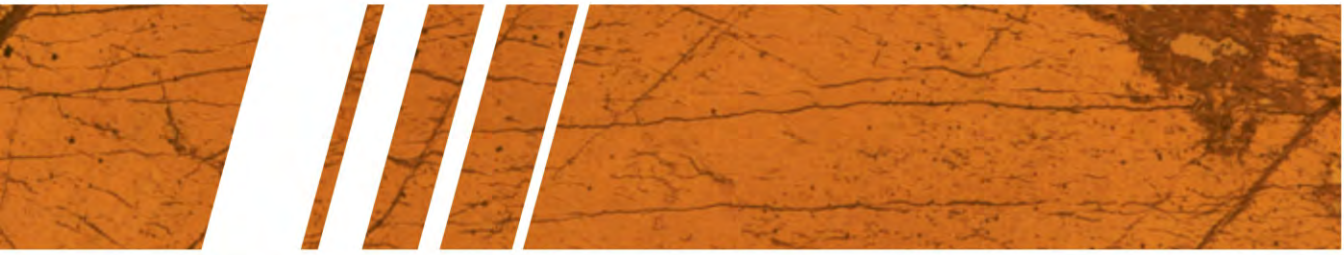
The conference kick-started with the keynote session by Ar. Lalichan Zacharias with an interesting topic, 'Stone-Frozen Poetry' followed by the sessions on 'Material Versatility in Architecture' chaired by Ar. Tushar Sogani. Other speakers include Ar. Damith Premathilake, Sri Lanka; Ar. Adrianta Aziz, Malaysia; Ar. Denny Setiawan, Indonesia and Ar. Anupam Mittal from India.

Thereafter, 'Inspirations from Heritage Architecture' was panelled by Ar. Sarosh Pradhan, Nepal; Ar. DH Wijewardhena, Sri Lanka; Ar. Shakoor Majid, Bangladesh and Ar. Madhup Mazumder, India, with panel-chair Ar. Kavita Jain, Jaipur.
